

Ministry of Immigration and Asylum publishes January 2026 data on unaccompanied minors

The Ministry of Immigration and Asylum published a factsheet on unaccompanied minors in Greece in January 2026. According to the factsheet, the estimated number of unaccompanied minors in Greece was 1,909 of whom:

- 93% boys
- 7% girls
- 13% < 15 years old
- 1,282 in accommodation centres
- 204 in semi-independent living apartments
- 119 in emergency accommodation structures
- 254 in Reception and Identification Centres (RICs) and Closed Controlled Access Centres (CCACs) on the islands
- 50 minors in Controlled Accommodation Facilities for Asylum Seekers.

The accommodation capacity for unaccompanied minors was:

- 1,745 places in accommodation structures (accommodation centres/semi-independent living apartments); and
- 153 places in emergency accommodation facilities.
