

Slovakia extends temporary protection for displaced persons from Ukraine until 4 March 2027 zzzzzz

Temporary protection for displaced persons from Ukraine was automatically extended until 4 March 2027, in line with the [Implementing Decision of the Council of the European Union](#). This extension is enabled by a Slovak government [resolution](#), which was approved on 21 February 2025. Individuals can check the validity of their temporary protection status through the Ministry of the Interior's [online portal](#).

After registering for temporary protection and submitting the application, applicants receive an A4 paper certificate which serves as a temporary residence document valid for up to 90 days, until a residence card is issued. If someone does not request the residence card during registration, for example if they do not yet have a delivery address, they may apply later. In that case, a new appointment must be booked through the Ministry of the Interior's booking system.
