

Government adopts amendments to remove Ukrainian men aged 18-60 from the collective protection scheme

The government adopted amendments to the regulations to remove Ukrainian men aged 18-60 from the collective protection scheme, meaning they will no longer automatically receive temporary residence permits based on group assessments. Instead, they must apply for protection on an individual basis. The change applies only to new applications and does not affect those who already have temporary collective protection, while some exceptions will still exist.
